Contestants must provide their own supplies: Hats, aprons, tables, chairs, utensils, grill, wood, charcoal, gas, ingredients, 150 foot extension cord, 100 foot garden hose, grill tent/cover, etc.

Beginning at 9:30 A.M. on November 3rd judging begins. A plate of BBQ must be ready for tasting

Cooking areas may be decorated with nonoffensive and non-business streamers, banners, flags, signs, etc., boasting about your team. Judging of Best Booth for each category will be announced November 3rd during Awards/Recognitions. COM-PANY ADVERTISING IS NOT PERMITTED.

Cancellations after October 23rd may result in the cook team being billed \$150 for the cost of the raw meat. "No shows" will be considered as cancellations.

All judging decisions are final.


