PROHIBITED ITEMS INCLUDE: Bottled water or soda products, fireworks, weapons, tee-shirts, and any food items other than baked goods. Any goods deemed inappropriate by the Pig on the Ridge Committee will be required to be removed.

We sincerely appreciate our vendors. However, due to the growing success of the BBQ portion of the Festival, the Pig on the Ridge Committee is being required by space restrictions to limit the number of vendor booths available.

10' X 10' booth space will be available on FRIDAY and SATURDAY on Ruff Street in front of the Mayor's house. 8' Table space will be available only on FRIDAY and SATURDAY along Palmer Street.

On SATURDAY only, Church Street between Palmer and Dogwood Street will be closed off, making this space available for 10' X 10' booths.

Please get your applications in as quickly as possible because space will fill quickly. We will offer spots on a waiting list in the case of cancellations.

Cost for a 10' X 10' SPACE: \$25 for Saturday and \$35 for both Friday night and Saturday.

An 8' TABLE SPACE on Palmer Street ONLY: \$10 Friday night, \$20 Saturday and \$25 for both days.

ALL SPACES ARE ASSIGNED. DO NOT SET UP WITHOUT AN ASSIGNED SPACE.

Electricity is EXTREMELY limited and cannot be promised. We will provide what we can. Please come prepared NOT to have electricity available. GENERATORS ARE NOT ALLOWED.

Our goal is to offer our festival visitors a nice variety of craft booths, resale booths, baked good vendors and informational booths. This may require that we limit and restrict some venues.

You can make a request on your application as to where you would like to be set up and if you require electricity. We will try to work within your preferences; however, the FINAL say will rest with the Pig on the Ridge Committee.

All applications are to be turned in WITH THE APPROPRIATE FEES no later than Saturday, Oct 21, 2016. We caution you to turn them in as soon as possible. Once the available spaces are filled, we have no further options beyond the waiting list.

Please return a completed application with a check payable to the Town of Ridgeway. They can be mailed or brought to the Ridgeway Town Hall at 170 S. Dogwood Ave., PO Box 24, Ridgeway, SC 29130 (803-337-2213). They can also be placed in an envelope and deposited in the outside drop box located on the South side of the Town Hall's circular driveway.

Upon acceptance of your application, you will be notified of your booth space number and location. Spaces WILL NOT be assigned or held without prior payment. Checks will be returned if you are not accepted.

FRIDAY set up time is 3:00 PM until 4:00 P.M. All vehicles must be immediately removed from the area after set up.

SATURDAY set up time is 7:30 A.M. until 8:30 A.M. All vehicles must be immediately removed from the area after set up.

PLEASE MAKE PRIOR ARRANGEMENTS IF YOU NEED TO COME BEFORE these scheduled times.

There will be volunteers available to help you find your assigned space prior to set up. SETTING UP IN THE WRONG SPACE WOULD REQUIRE YOU TO MOVE YOUR DISPLAY.

You MUST stay within your assigned space and vehicles must be moved. Please keep your space neat and clean and remove your trash when you leave.
