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Vendors:

We sincerely appreciate our vendors. However, due to the growing success of the BBQ portion of the Festival, the Pig on the Ridge Committee is being required by space restrictions to limit the number of vendor booths available. Our goal is to offer our festival visitors a nice variety of craft booths, resale booths, baked good vendors and informational booths. This may require that we limit and restrict some venues.

Applications:

Please get your applications in as quickly as possible because space will fill quickly. We will offer spots on a waiting list in the case of cancellations.

Deadline is October 15th. All applications are to be turned in with appropriate fees.

Please return a completed application with a check payable to the Town of Ridgeway. They can be mailed to PO Box 24, Ridgeway, SC 29130 or brought to the Ridgeway Town Hall at 170 S. Dogwood Ave., (803-337-2213). They can also be placed in an envelope and deposited in the outside drop box located on the South side of the Town Hall's circular driveway.

You can make a request on your application as to where you would like to be set up and if you require electricity. We will try to work within your preferences; however, the FINAL say will rest with the Pig on the Ridge Committee. Electricity is EXTREMELY limited and cannot be promised. We will provide what we can. Please come prepared NOT to have electricity available. GENERATORS ARE NOT ALLOWED.

You will be notified of your booth space number and location on November 4th. Please look out for our email. Spaces will not be held without prior payment. Checks will be returned if you are not accepted.

Set Up:

ALL SPACES ARE ASSIGNED. DO NOT SET UP WITHOUT AN ASSIGNED SPACE.

SETTING UP IN THE WRONG SPACE WOULD REQUIRE YOU TO MOVE YOUR DISPLAY.

SET UP TIME: FRIDAY is 3:00 pm until 4:00 pm.

SET UP TIME: SATURDAY is 7:30 am - 8:30 am.

All vehicles must be immediately removed from the area after set up.

Please make prior arrangements you need to come before these scheduled times.

There will be volunteers available to help you find your assigned space prior to set up.

You MUST stay within your assigned space and vehicles must be moved. Please keep your space neat and clean and remove your trash when you leave.
